CNITS are determined by Alberta Seniors and is responsible for calculating Core Need Income Thresholds (CNITs) for rural communities and reflect the income needed to pay market rent in the community.

Households seeking subsidized housing accommodation must have total household income below CNIT for the size of unit they qualify to live in.
